- e. To immediately intervene in case of calamities, disasters or accidents
- f. To ensure respect of laws relating to airspace, borders and waters
- g. To participate in international peacekeeping, humanitarian assistance and training operations
- h. To provide fire- fighting services
- i. To conduct general search of any premise as it considers necessary
- j. To ensure the safety of infrastructure and public buildings

CADET COURSE RECRUITMENT CONDITIONS

5. Any person to be admitted in Rwanda National Police must meet the following conditions:

- 1) To be Rwandan by Nationality
- 2) Have the willingness to serve in the force
- 3) To be between 21 and 25 years
- 4) To have at least university degree (A0) in Law, Information Technology, Engineering, Medicine, Journalism, Languages and Education
- 5) Not to have had any criminal conviction of more than six months
- 6) To be exemplary and recommended by your cell executive secretary
- 7) Not have been dismissed by any function of public service
- 8) To be healthy and strong enough to work in Police, and medically recommended by a Police medic. Medical examination will be only carried out to those who will go through preliminary selection
- 9) To be ready to work in any police deployment
- 10) Selected applicants must pass the recruitment test for Cadet Course
